Update from Ghana

Greetings from Tamale, Ghana!

Term 1 reading materials for grade 2 are finished! By God's grace, we were able to finish on schedule and turned in the material last Wednesday before the Easter break. The 5-day break over Easter has been a blessing. I stayed in Tamale and since there isn't much to do here, I was able to relax, catch up on sleep, read and do laundry (by hand ☺). Today we started working on the material for Term 2. The material developed for Term 1 reviewed all the letters and language concepts taught in Grade 1. Developing the material for Term 2 will be more challenging since it includes new letters and complex language features.

I am amazed and impressed by the skill, diligence and hard work that our writers and illustrators exhibited in the first half of the workshop. We are under pressure to produce quality material in a short amount of time. Each team was responsible to produce 10 weeks of material (8 Read Aloud texts, 8 Shared Reading texts, 20 Leveled Texts. & Teacher's Guide). I've included an example story (*at right*) and illustration (*below*).
